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Dear Parents and Friends of Stafford Manor,

Please could I ask for your support with ensuring that your child continues to attend Stafford Manor High School in full school uniform.

We can appreciate that the weather is warming up now, which is pleasing, as it is encouraging more of our students to be outside int he fresh air during break and lunch.

However, we would ask please that students attend in full uniform.

Once the weather is warm enough, we will be allowing boys to attend in tailored shorts. Girls are permitted to wear skirts as part of our uniform, but these should be knee length please.

It is also advised that your child bring a water bottle to remain hydrated during the day, these can be filled up at our hydration station in the canteen at break and lunch but not during lesson time please.

The school will ensure that windows are opened to encourage air flow through the building and into classrooms. We will be advising all students to think about how active they are when the weather is hot and also encouraging them to find shade during lunch.

Sun cream would also be advisable for students to apply before leaving home for school.

Please could we ask that children do not bring water pistols or other similar toys to school that carry water. Using these causes disruption to learning, as it often means students are wet after social time, which often means students are more uncomfortable in lessons. This also causes a hazard inside the building, as the water gets onto the floor and makes it slippy and dangerous.

Finally, we will, as always, get to a point when the weather may be too hot for ties and blazers. We are NOT at this point yet based on a slight rise in temperate this week. The school will notify parents and students in advance if it gets too hot for ties, blazers and when boys can begin to wear tailored shorts. For the time being, please send your child in full school uniform.

### **Mental Health Awareness Week**

Its is mental health awareness week next week and the school will be encouraging students to move more and to seek support if they need it with their mental health and delivering lessons on how students can help their own mental health. Please ask them about their learning on this in school and talk to them about how they are feeling.

Reliable, Hardworking, Honest, Sensible and Enthusiastic?


### Could you...

The Book club is available to all Yr7-9 pupils and it will be held in the library from 1.40-2:10 every Tuesday and Thursday.


