I would like to draw your attention to **Section 7**: How to revise for the exams in November (and beyond).

To improve their grade, it is expected that at least one hour of independent work/homework is carried out every night, as well as 15 hours of revision throughout a half term. A blank revision timetable, which can be used to plan out revision time over half term is present towards the back of the brochure. It would be useful to help your child plan a mixture of bronze, silver and gold days made up of the following hours per day:

Bronze days: 2 hoursSilver days: 3 hoursGold Days: 4 hours

"Year 11 is going to go so quickly, and before you know it, you will be sitting your final GCSE exams in the hall. The mocks will help you become fully prepared for this.
